Located in SW3 of Sect. Sect. 29 Twp. 27S, Rge. 25 E. on highway # 69

From the SW cor. of Sect. 29 go N about 1/3 mi. open gate & follow graveled

lane toE about 500 ft. to cem. on a little hill. The cem. is perhaps 150 ft.

square, is fenced, has new metal fence posts and a wire gate. There are a dozen

or more cedar trees in the cem. It appears to have had some care in recent

years. This is about 1 mi. E of Drywood.
