PITTSBURG GARDEN OF MEMORIES

Located NE $\frac{1}{4}$ (& Faith Garden in SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Sect. 19, Township 29 S. Rge 25 E.

This is 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ mi. N of 4th & Broadway, Pittsburg, Kansas, along the W side of highway #69.

The caretaker stated the first burial was made in January, 1954, but several bodies were moved in from other cemeteries, whose stones show earlier death dates. This cem. is beautifully cared for, and graves are marked with flat headstones, all of which are of bronze, deeply engraved with many different designs, and attached to marble or cement stones. Many have built-in urns, and there are a great many artificial flowers in evidence.

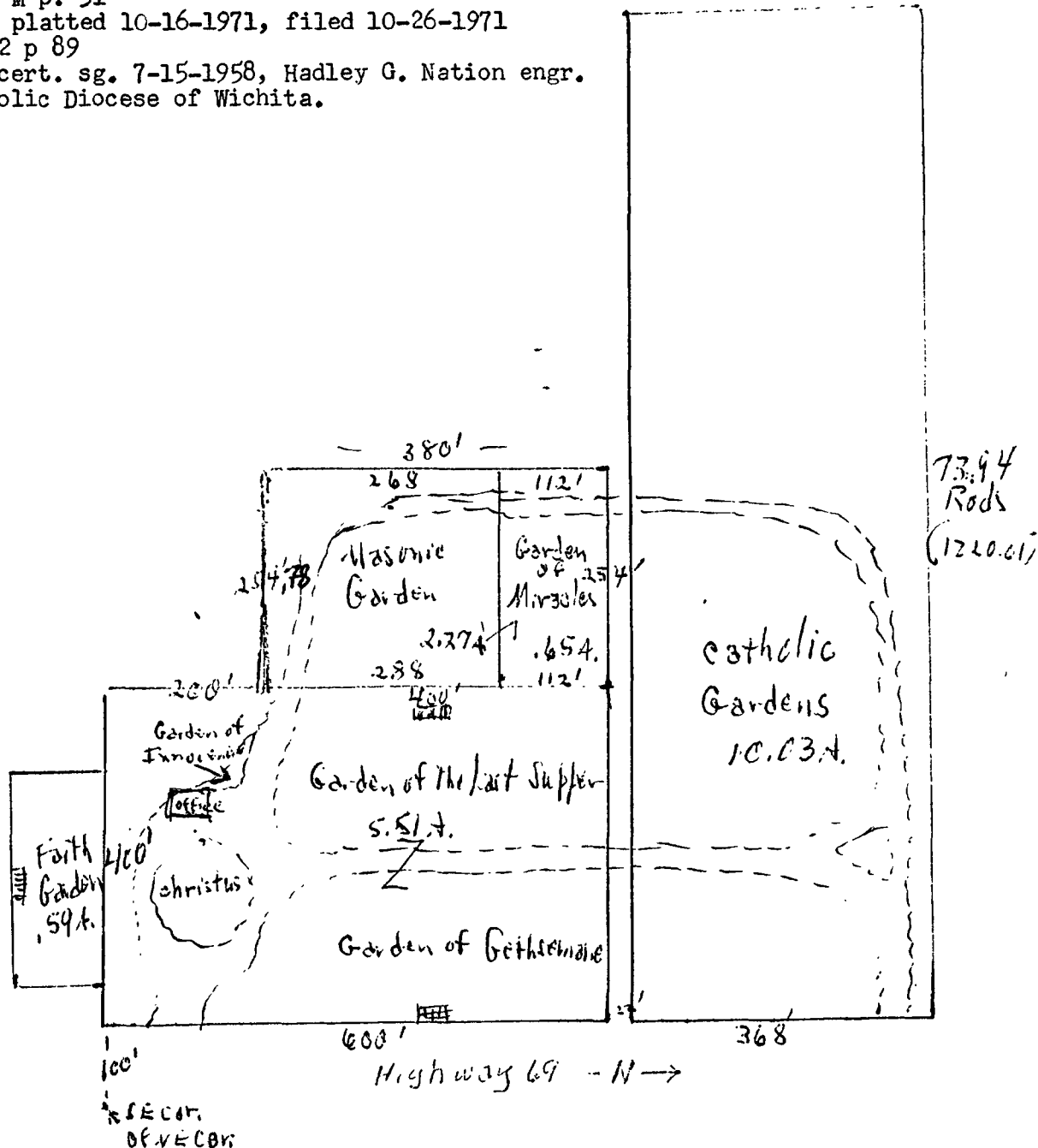
