HOBSON CEMETERY

Located in the SW2 of the SW2 of Sect. 32-30-25

This is nearly 2 mi. S of the intersection of 4th Street and Broadway in Pittsburg, Kansas, on the E side of the street(S. Broadway), which is the county mile road.

This is sometimes considered to be a part of the newer Highland Park Cemetery which adjoins it on the M, see map of Highland Park Cem. for further explanation.

Upon entering the wide gateway to Highland Park Cem., a row of large varits or mausoleums above ground may be seen to the S of this entrance area. The old Pittsburg or Hobson Cemetery begins just to the S of these vaults, and occupies an area 317 ft. E-W (including a 39 ft. set-back from the center of S. Broadway) and 528 ft. N-S. The lots are 10 ft. F-W and 20 ft. N-S. Each block of lots is 50 ft. F-W and 60 ft. N-S, containing 15 lots. There are 5 of these blocks E-W and 8 N-S, separated by 4 ft. walks, this area being surrounded by a space of 8 ft. on the N, 12 ft. on the E and S, and 39 ft. on the N. The W 220 ft. of the 8 ft. walkway along the N side later became a part of "Vault Row", see Highland Park Cem. records. The newer Highland Park Cem. adjoins it on the N and E, and St. Nary's Catholic Cem. on the S, the boundaries being hardly visible, although a driveway follows the K half of the south boundary.

Land records of CrawfordCo. show that George Hobson rec'd a land patent from the $U_{\bullet, S}$. Govt. on 15th July 1870 to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of 32-30-25 (along with the $\frac{1}{2}$ of same SW $\frac{1}{4}$.)

The plat to this cem., in the office of the Register of Deeds of Crawford Co., kans., shows that it was located in the NW cor. of the SW2 of the SW2 of Sect. 32-30-25.

The oldest birth date is that of Margaret, wife of M. A. Hurt, who died June 30 1883, aged 84-9-12, which indicates her birth date would have been Sept. 18, 1798, see p. 22. On p. 8, Charles Spragg born Jan 22 1805, appears to be the next oldest.
