NEW BUSINESS

Item One: Mr. Don Pyle addressed the Commissioners in reference to the 2018 proposed budgets for Fire District #1 and Fire District #2. He stated that Mr. Mike Ryan, Fire District #1 Chief attended a previous meeting and spoke to the Commissioners about increasing Fire District #1 2018 levy from 5 mills to 6.5 mills. Mr. Pyle explained that he was contacted by Fire District #2 asking for an increase in the levy from 5 mills to 7 mills. Mr. Pyle and the Commissioners discussed the total budgets for 2017 for both fire districts and compared with the requested increases. Mr. Pyle answered the Commissioners that Fire District #3 and Fire District #4 both stayed at the 5 mils and did not request an increase. The Commissioners requested that Mr. Mike McLeod, Fire District #2 Chief attend the meeting on Friday to explain the reasoning for the mill increase request.

Item Two: Mr. Jim Emerson, County Counselor stated he is working on contracts with Mr. Robert Gorentz, Maintenance Supervisor for the new road and bridge buildings and should have them ready Friday.

Item Three: Commissioner Murphy reported on the fairground renovations and stated he is very pleased with the progress and the outcome.

Item Four: Mr. Murphy asked about the chip and seal time line and Commissioner Wood gave an update on the status of the project.

Item Five: Mr. Murphy asked about the status of correcting the entrance to the courthouse parking lot and Mr. Pyle stated the contractor has reported that when the project is completed they will come back to tear out and correct the entrance. The Commissioners discussed paving the parking lot at the courthouse. Mr. Murphy stated he was concerned with drainage and would like Mr. Ron Albertini, County Surveyor, to look at the parking lot and the drainage around the courthouse.

Item Six: Mr. Wood discussed strobe lights for the dump trucks and the Commissioners agreed to make a change order and include the lights for safety reasons.

Item Seven: Mr. Wood stated that he and Mr. Gorentz will be meeting with Westar about changing the entrance at the Freeto Building for the new road and bridge building.

Item Eight: The Commissioners discussed the use of equipment by the Road and Bridge Districts.

MESSAGES FROM THE PUBLIC

Item One: Mr. Mike Williams from Pro Energy Solutions addressed the Commissioners about his company.
