McCUNE CEMETERY

Located SE cor. Sect. 7 Twp. 31S Rge 22E

This is less than 1 mi. W of McCune, on the NW cor. of the intersection.

The older part on the corner of the intersection is bisected by a road N-S and another E-W, dividing it into 4 quarters. The newer part is located some distance W of the older part and separated from it by unused ground. A flagpole is located where the 2 roads bisect in the older part, and we began here, at the center of the older part, in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the cem., from N to S, then back from S to N on next row to E, etc. The 1906 Plat Book of Crawford Co. shows the cem. occupying 5 a.; this is probably the older part only. (began copying 12-15-1966)

9-20-1971: Mr. & Mrs. Kirkland of the Kirkland Insurance Agency, McCune, Kans., have the McCune cem. records, and provided this information:

McCune was incorporated as a city on Oct. 9 1881.

The City of McCune purchased from Naomi Coultis on Jan. 4 1882 for \$150, 5 acres, more or less, in the SE cor. of Sect. 7, Twp. 31S Rge 22E....for a cem.

Slightly before this, Nov 1 1881, the cem. records show that the first lots were purchased by S. A. McCune (2 lots) and T. W. Stutterd, both on Nov. 1st. Burial records go back to 1888.

The Kirklands believed that most of the burials dated before 1882 were likely moved in from farms etc., although it was thought possible that some might have been buried here before the cem. was platted. (However, all appear to be in straight rows as though burials were all made after the platting was done.)

The Kirklands also had the old funeral records of the Gregg Funeral Home. Their first funeral, #1, was that of Charles H. Williams in 1900.

Land records show McCune cem. in SE cor of 7-31-22, being a square lot of 5 acres. The plat surveyed by H. A. Howard, surveyor & civil engineer, and dated June 6, 1892.

The West addition to McCune: Beginning at NW cor of McCune cem., W 28.28 rods, S 28.28 rods, E 28.28 rods & N 28.28 rods to beginning. Surveyed by W.H. Kutz of Parsons Ks. 9-23-1912. Dedicated 9-26-1912, at which time W. E. Gregg was mayor and W. H. Gracey, deputy.

DEATHS before 1882.⁽⁴⁰⁾ The cemetery was purchased 1-4-1882, so it seems likely that most of these persons were moved in from other burial places. Note that S. A. McCune and T. W. Stutterd purchased lots 11-1-1881. In the following list there were deaths in McCune and Stutterd families in Aug. & Oct., 1881, resp., so it seems likely that burials were made a few months before the actual purchase was completed.

McCune Cemetery Notes

NOTE: AZARIAH RIGGS is not buried at McCune, Kansas. (d. 1856)

p. 28 McCune Cem.: "Azariah Riggs 1797-1856 his wife Susan 1805-1875"

This stone is on the lot of Perry Riggs, a son of Azariah. The death date for Azariah is the oldest found thus far in Crawford County Kansas. However, the following seems to prove that he is not buried here, but back in Missouri.

Mrs. C. E. (Vivian) Riggs, 2035 NW 31, Oklahoma City, Okla., 73118, furnished this information:

"Azariah, born 1797 - died 1856. His wife Susan Shepherd was born 1805 - died 1875. Their early married life was spent in Grainger County, near Morristown in Eastern Tennessee. In 1854 they, with their family, moved to a farm near Shelbyville, Mo.Susan Riggs was accepting notes for the property sold in 1868. However, there is no burial record in Shelby County.

"In 1868 Susan Riggs and her 3 youngest children moved to a farm $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles NW of McCune, Kansas. This came to be known as the Perry Riggs farm. Those 3 children were Perry, Ellis and Roena.

"Information from step-daughter of Perry - Nelle Davis, Tulsa - 'I know that they came to Kansas after the war as my stepfather was in the war in Mo. Also his father (Azariah) died before that time and is not buried in McCune. Susan Riggs' body was moved from a country cemetery north east of McCune. I well remember that as she is now buried on Perry's lot.'

"Two others say the same about Susan Riggs but do not know about Azariah, except that he is not at McCune.

"David, Ninion, Ellis and Perry were all in the war and I have typed what I knew about Perry's service on the other page. David was killed but under unusual circumstances. This came from the Missouri Historical Soc. According to them Jesse James and a group of outlaws took 75 Union soldiers off a train and shot them. This was at Centralia, Mo., on Sept. 27, 1864. They are all buried at Jefferson City, Mo. and a marker of the event is near the depot at Centralia.

"Private Perry Riggs, age 23, enrolled July 25, 1862 at Shelbyville, Mo. 70 Reg. EMM to 2nd Prov. Regt. Co. B. Enrolled Missouri Militia March 27 1863. Ordered into active service April 1, 1863, at Shelbyville. Relieved from duty Nov. 14, 1863."

Note: Perry Riggs was the father of P.B.(Bill) Riggs, who was the father of Wilbur Riggs of Girard.
