CEMETERY**

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OLD ARCADIA, WEST HILL CEMETERY

located in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sect. 36, Twp. 27S, Rge 25 E.

At the W edge of Arcadia, turn N just W of the railroad tracks & follow the road N a little more than  $\frac{1}{2}$  mi. to where it crosses Cox Creek; at this point the road turns W, and the entrance to the cem. is to the E.

This cem. appears to consist of 3 sections: a very old section to the E, a later section in the center, and a newer one to the W. In the older E part we found this stone: (p. 7) "Hathaway Philip W. 1816-1873 L11 $\frac{1}{2}$ , both 1819-1858 Lucy C. 1840-1860". Also on the same stone: "This cemetery dedicated to wife Elizabeth who was first to sleep herein." Land records show that Phillip W. Hathaway rec'd a land patent from the U.S. Govt. on May 6 1870 to the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of this section; but previously Mr. Hathaway had made a deed, 11-11-1869, to Wm. W. Duckeman. The 1906 Atlas of Crawford Co. shows a cem. at this place, slightly angled, and longer E-W than N-S; we believe it may have extended farther E than the present E boundary. This was likely known as the Arcadia cem. in early days.

Forest Hill Cem. was platted 8-22-1899, Christoph Schmitt, owner, the description being as follows: Commencing 11 rods S of NE cor of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of above Sect. 36, W 15 rods, S 32 rods, E 15 rods, N 32 rods to beginning, EXCEPTING therefrom a part of the Arcadia Kansas Cem. The plat shows that this covers the old E and later middle sections, and was 525' along the E and W sides, and 247 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' along the N & S ends. The older part is shown to be the NE part, angling in such a way as to leave some wedge-shaped pieces, but approx. 362' long N-S and 151 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' wide E-W. Therefore the S 166' of the old E part appears to have been platted with the middle section in 1899.

The new west section is properly called "West Ridge Add. to Forest Hill Cem." & was platted in 1931 by James L. Dearing, surveyor. It was dedicated by Amelia Brumbarger, widow, 11-13-1931, and described as follows: Commencing 9' W of SW cor. of lot 456 of the Forest Hill cem. (said lot 456 being duly recorded), N 155', W 300', S 200', thence in Northeasterly direction 305' to place of beginning.

"Old Arcadia" seems to be the name everyone uses for this cem., Mr. Truman Ballard who is in charge of the cem. had not heard of the name Forest Hill. He owns land to the N & E. He said the town of Arcadia began here and was later moved to its present location.

The cem. is well-kept for an old one, 2 men were spreading dirt in sunken places and cutting brush in fence rows. The location is on a hill with much brush around it, Cox creek flows to the S & E a short distance. It was extremely difficult to copy the oldest E part by rows, due to the fact these rows angled variously; likely this is due to the fact that the old part was laid off at a slight angle originally.

Mr. Ed Dobbins (12-13-1971) a barber at Arcadia, extremely well-versed in Arcadia history, was keeper of the cem. records for about 20 years, before Mr. Ballard had them. He recalled the name of Forest Hill, but said no one used it. He said the NE part was an older cemetery. Mr. Schmidt, once a barber in A.C., owned land to the W, and his dau. was Mrs. Brumbarger, who lived in the house to the W, was the mother of Mrs. Dearing who owned the new W add.

Mr. Cody Bailey (12-13-1971) residing 1 mi W of Arcadia, 3 mi N & 3/4 W recalled helping dig graves here as a young man. He had heard the story that a number of people died of smallpox in an epidemic in early days, and some were even buried here in the middle of the night. Mrs. Dearing, owner of lots in the new W part, now living in Ft. Scott, was related to those buried at the Dearing or Nance Cem. SE of Cato.

Mrs. Maude Jewell Evans, nee Taylor (12-18-1971), stated that her mother-in-law was a Hathaway. Phillip Hathaway lived just W of the cem. on the next little hill. His wife Elizabeth was ill, probably of consumption. She called out the window to him that when she died she wanted to be buried over on the little hill--and he carried out her wishes, so that she was the first one buried here. Mr. Hathaway was a blacksmith. Col. Jewell was first buried at the battle of Cane Hill in Ark., then moved to the Nat'l. cem. at Ft. Scott, and later moved to this cem. Joe Nelson was first postmaster at Arcadia which was located near the present location.
