Located in SW cor. of Sect. 2, Twp. 28 S Rge. 25 E.

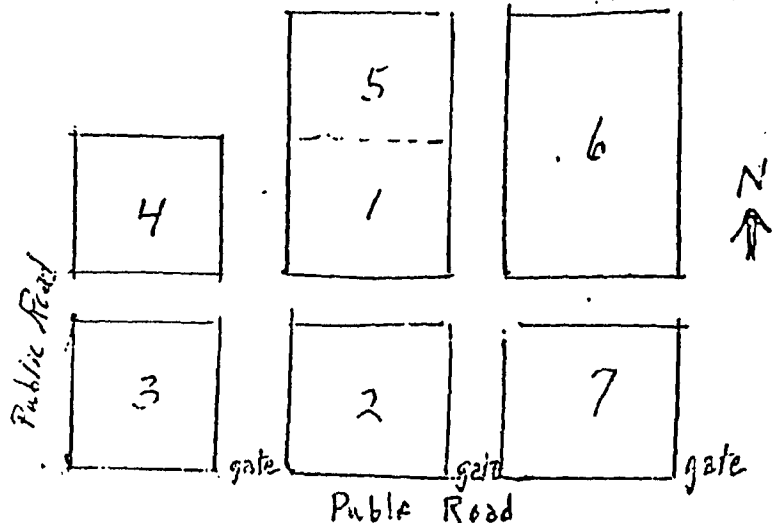
This is 1 mi. W and 1 mi. S from the W edge of Arcadia, Ks.

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There are 3 entrances on the S, with drive-ways running N, dividing the cem. into a W section, a MIDDLE section and an E section.

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The cem. seems to be supported by donations, and was well-kept. It is at the edge of a hill, falling steeply to the NW, and almost surrounded by strip coal mining. There are a number of cedar trees.

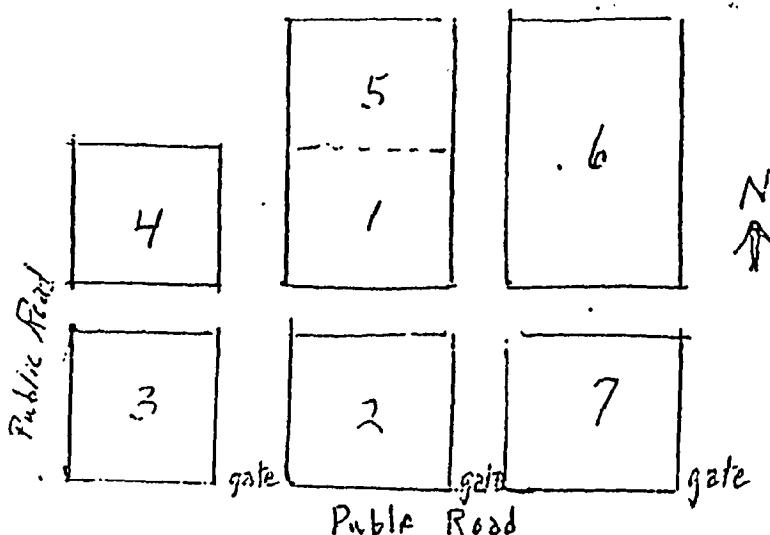
