Stay home and wait for your test results.

If you test <u>POSITIVE</u> for COVID-19:

ISOLATE

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Seek treatment early.
- Stay home for at least 5 days.
- Stay home as long as you have symptoms.
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms resolve, you can leave your house after a minimum of 5 days of isolation.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days after you leave isolation.

If you have been <u>EXPOSED</u> to COVID-19:

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.
- If you develop symptoms at any time, get tested and stay home.
