## BEVANS GRAVE

located N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sect. 14, Twp. 30 S., Rge. 25 E., E of Litchfield, a mining town which no longer exists.

1-26-1973 Mrs. Alice Arbuckle of Cherokee, Kansas, stated that her great-grandfather, James Bevans, is buried on his farm a short distance E of the location where the school was in Litchfield. She had seen the stone, it had the design of a wagon wheel on it. She had not been to the site for several years, and did not know if it was still there.

Mrs. Arbuckle also recalled a small burial ground in Litchfield, see other notes concerning it, with the unknown burials.
