# FAIRVIEW ENGLEVALE CEMETERY

Crawford County Genealogy Society

Located about mid-way along the N side of Sect. 25, Two 283, Rg. 24E. This is just to the S of the county mile road along the R side of above section, Just to the E of the cem., the road curves to the NE to Englevale about a to i mi. away. The cem. is long N-S and narrow E-d. It is well fenced and attended. There are 2 gates along the road, with a driveway going straight S to the end of the cem. from

each gate, and these 2 drives are connected at the S end, dividing the cem. into 3 long N-S sections.

The section " of the " driveway has 3 long N-o rows of graves, as does the one E of the E drive. The section between the driveways has 4 long N-S rows.

We began copying on the W row, so rows 1,2 & 3 are in the W section; rows 4,5,6  $\pm$  7 are in the center section, and rows 8,9  $\pm$  10 are in the E section.

Three persons buriedhere died in 1676, the earliest year of death found, and only 2 others predate 1880:
