## HEPLER CEMETERY


Located in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sect. 26 Twp. 27S Rge.22 E

This is just N of Hepler on the W side of the road, the road being on the  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile line. This is about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mi S of the Bourbon Co. line, and appears to be in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sect. 26, 10 acres according to the 1906 Atlas of Crawford Co.

11-2-1971 Wm. Cuthbertson finished copying cem., and contacted Paul Hager of Hepler who has access to the cemetery records & plat. The oldest receipt stub for sale of a lot was dated 1-26-1910. City ordinances date from #1 in 1887, and we found no mention of the cemetery. The plat map shows date of 3-2-1953. Mr. Hager believes all the earlier records were destroyed in the big fire (which occurred Aug. 23 1893).

The cemetery is neatly kept and has many cedar trees. A central driveway has sign "Hepler Cemetery" over the gate; this drive divides the cem. into a S  $\frac{1}{2}$  and a N  $\frac{1}{2}$ . In each  $\frac{1}{2}$  there were other driveways dividing it into 4 sections. We copied the S $\frac{1}{2}$  first, beginning with 1st section back from road, etc.; then N $\frac{1}{2}$ , again beginning with 1st section back from road.

The cem. plat shows each of these 8 sections actually cont<sub>g</sub> in 2 sections, and we sketch a little map as follows: (The # numbers are the official cem. nos.)



Therefore: 1st Sect. back

on S is #9 & #16

2nd Sect. on S is #10 & #15

3rd Sect. on S is #11 & #14

4th Sect. on S is # 12 & # 13

1st Sect. on N is #1 & # 8

2nd Sect. on N is #2 & #7

3rd Sect. on N is #3 & # 6

4th Sect. on N is #4 & #5

Older records indicate this was once a Township Cemetery.
