#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

**Item One:** County Clerk Don Pyle regarding the 2013 Real Estate Appraisal/Sales Ratio Study received from the Kansas Division of Property Valuation. Mr. Pyle stated that this study is received annually from the Division of Property Valuation and that it calculates how close the appraised values are to actual sales prices for properties in the county during the previous year. They discussed the study and how it reviews the sales of property in all the property classes.

### **UNDER THE HEADING OLD BUSINESS**

**Item One:** County Clerk Don Pyle regarding a meeting with department heads in the courthouse and Craw-Kan representatives to discuss the possible changes in phone service that could be made in the future. It was discussed that the employees of Craw-Kan had discussed some new possibilities for the configuration of phone lines in the courthouse and how the automated attendant function would integrate into those possibilities. It was discussed that the system could have an automated attendant system for people that do not call a specific office at the courthouse but the system could still have phone calls go directly to offices if the caller has the direct phone number. Mr. Pyle also stated that he would be contacting department heads to ask them how many phones would be needed in each of their offices if a new phone system would require that all of the phones be replaced. There was also a discussion of some of the advantages that a new phone system would have and that it could eliminate several phone lines. It was still apparent that a few more meetings would be needed to get to a point where the county could have some numbers to look at for a new phone system.
