St. Patrick's Cemetery
Walnut

Located SE cor. of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 14, Twp. 28S Rge. 21E.

This is $\frac{1}{2}$ mi N of the highway that passes E-W through Walnut, on the W side of the road. Glenwood Cem. adjoins St. Patrick's on the N. The 1906 Plat Book of Crawford Co. shows this cem. area occupying 10 acres, but shows no distinction between the two. It would then appear that St. Patrick's occupies the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 14, and Glenwood occupies the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of same. A fence separates the two.

At a later date it will likely be difficult to locate a grave from our copy, due to the fact that there are probably several rows at both the E & W ends which have not been used, and possibly some rows with no graves as yet between rows we copied. We simply numbered the rows in which we found graves, from E to W, S side first, and these are not official numbers. There are many vacant spaces. *

11-17-1971: Mr. Clarence Pate of Walnut recalled that Father Doyle, the young priest who is buried in front of the large monument to the W of the center of the cem., was the son of the contractor who built the Walnut Catholic Church about 1884, which church burned several years ago. Father Doyle celebrated his first mass in that church, built by his father.

11-20-1971 Fr. Robt. Watson priest of St. Patrick's Parish, gave this information. The Parish was originally a part of Greenbush Parish, which may account for the fact that we have not found Catholic burials in this community in the early days; burials at that time apparently were made at Greenbush. The Parish was established in 1869 at the home of a Mr. Clements, who, himself, was not a Catholic. Father F. M. Verdan of Greenbush began the church building, which was finished in 1886. The first resident pastor came in 1900. Father Joseph Paul Doyle was the first student priest from this diocese, and also the first native Kansan to be ordained a Catholic priest. His father was Joseph Doyle, of this parish, also bur. in the cem. Father Doyle was ordained June 10 1904 and celebrated his first mass in St. Patrick's church June 12, 1904. His death in 1906 was caused by a brain tumor.

Records were not available to show the date of beginning of this cemetery, but apparently about the time of adjoining Glenwood, which was granted a charter July 30 1897. We found 2 burials in 1897, 4 in 1898, 5 in 1899. Previous to this we found the following 6 death dates, and it is possible they might have been moved in from other locations:

* It may be noted that on the S side, the space between rows 17 & 18 lined up with the center monument, and on the N side, the space between rows 11 & 12 lined up with the same. On the N side, all the graves are near the center driveway, leaving much unoccupied space along the N side of the cem.

The monument has a picture in color on the granite of the Last Supper, and is topped with a large granite cross with inscription "INRI". On the back of this monument "Erected by the Mullins in memory of Mullin & Doyle families."
