WALNUT CEMETERY

Located NE cor. of Sect. 11 Twp. 28S Rge. 21E

This is 2 mi. N of Walnut, Kansas, on the SW cor. of the intersection. A placque on the E gatepost reads: "Walnut Cemetery Established 1870".

The cem. is long N-S, and consists of 3 sections, full length N-S, divided by driveways. A later addition which appears much newer has been added to the S.

The 1906 Plat Book of Crawford Co. shows 6 a. in the cem., the land from which it was taken was owned by J. A. Marshall.

11-16-1971 Harvey McFarland of Walnut, grandson of J. A. Marshall, stated that his grandfather came to the area in 1870 and gave the land for the cem. that same year. The gift included the East and Middle sections of the cem. The gate at the E entrance was at the S boundary of the original cem., and the gate at the N entrance was at the W boundary of the original part. The lots were free in these 2 sections. Later the West section was added, and many years later the new part to the South, consisting of 2 sections divided by a driveway, was added, and the lots in these areas were sold.

The three older sections have many cedar and catalpa trees. Throughout the cemetery the rows of stones run N-S.

The East section in the original part is narrow, having only 2 rows of graves N-S.

The Middle section has some very crooked rows. At the S end it appears there are 6 rows of stones, but at the N end it looks more like 8 rows. We divided it into 8 rows to copy, but due to the extreme unevenness, especially in rows 3, 4 & 5, our copy may be difficult to follow.

The West section appears to have 7 very wide rows, each row evidently being wide enough for 2 rows of graves. Since there are not many stones between these 7 main rows, we divided it into 7 rows for copying. From the N gate, a driveway angles SW to the W side of the cem., leaving a triangular part in the NW corner which is grown up in grass, and which appears to have no tombstones. Aside from this, the cem. is well kept.

The New S part of the cem. is divided into an E part and a W part by a driveway, there being 5 rows (N-S) in each part.

Miss Ethel Pate (11-17-1971) had heard that the first burial in the cem. was a Mr. Ecke; his wife remarried a Mr. Hunker. (Note: n. 2 Henry C. Ecke d 12-10-1871).

George Riebe of Girard had heard the first burial was a baby who d. in a covered wagon passing through; and that his grandmother Elizabeth Riebe was the lith., having d. 1880 the year she came. She is bur. E of drive along W side of mid-section abt. 3/4 of way from N to S, & not marked but by a small number.

Mrs. Emma Johnston, nee Frear of Walnut, whose g-fa. Frear was postmaster at Walnut (then 2 mi E & 1 S--SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 20-28-22) when the Walnut P.O. was moved into Glenwood & the name changed to Walnut, said that a robbery of a hardware store in Walnut many yrs. ago resulted in a man being killed. He was buried in the NE cor. of the cem., grave unmarked, and no one ever knew who he was. (note of 11-9-1971)

Mr. Milton McClintick of 3 mi E and 2 mi S of Walnut (10-27-1971) recalled hearing that the Loomis family and others in early days brought their slaves with them and some of these slaves are buried in unmarked graves in the NW cor. of the cem. in the triangular area where there are no markers and where it has not been mowed. (Note: This area appears to have not been in the original cem.; also note a former slave bur. in SE cor. of orig. part--first burial listed in copy).

11-17-1971: Miss Florence Goff of Walnut recalled the stone, near the E gate, of a Mr. Brakebill, a horse thief. (We did not find the stone.)

Walnut Cemetery, additional notes:

Concerning the West section, Geo. Smith, Wm. R. Samples & Chas. H. Holmes certified they were owners of this area and dedicated it 4-5-1890. Commencing at NW cor. of old cemetery, S 40 rods, along W side of cem., W 12 rods, N 40 rods, & E 12 rods to beginning, containing 3 acres.
