

ATTENTION CRAWFORD COUNTY RESIDENTS

Beginning May 1<sup>st</sup> the landfill free Saturday will be changed. There will no longer be one set day for free disposal. As of May 1<sup>st</sup> each Crawford County resident will be allowed 1 free disposal load per month at any time during the month during the landfill operating hours of 7am to 4pm sharp, Monday-Friday and 8am to 11am Saturday.

All free day rules apply. Loads must be tarped or secured to prevent the loss of waste from the vehicle. Loads are limited to the size of a full sized pickup truck or trailer no longer than 8 feet in length. Loads are subject to refusal if found to contain unapproved waste, including; white goods, water heaters, ovens, refrigerators, freezers, etc., car batteries, whole tires, medical waste, asbestos containing materials, free liquids including oil, fuel gasoline, paint, etc., roofing materials including shingles are allowed as long as they were not from a commercial project.

Loads will be tracked by name and vehicle tag number. You must have a valid Crawford County Vehicle Tag or other proof of County residence. Please have your information ready when you arrive at the landfill. Free disposal is limited to one load per person per month. Additional loads will be charged at the posted gate rate of \$43.00 per ton, with a minimum of \$43.00 if less than 1 ton. The landfill will waive the additional environmental fee and fuel surcharges on all Crawford County residents, noncommercial loads only. This will result in a savings of over \$4.00 per ton.

This new free dumping policy is another way the County, area cities and Oak Grove Landfill are cooperating to help control illegal dumping. Please remember to have loads completely covered as this will be a point of emphasis for law enforcement. Illegally dumped loads should be reported to the Crawford County Sheriff's Department.
