Advance Voting Continues

Crawford County continues to assist voters with voting advance ballots both by mail and in person. Advance ballots by mail can be applied for until October 27, 2020, so please apply as soon as possible if you choose to vote by mail. Individuals can apply online at www.ksvotes.org or they can mail an application to our office. Applications are available by calling our office at 620-724-6115 or on our website at <https://www.crawfordcountykansas.org/advanced-ballot.html>

Crawford County has 2 ballot drop boxes available for voters to return their ballots which are emptied on a daily basis by election workers. They are located in the parking areas of the Crawford County Judicial Center located at 602 N. Locust Street in Pittsburg and at the Crawford County Courthouse located at 111 E. Forest Street in Girard. Look for the red, white and blue metal boxes at these locations. These boxes are monitored by security cameras.

There are also opportunities to vote an advance ballot in person before election day. The Homer Cole Center at 3003 North Joplin St. in Pittsburg and the Meadowbrook Mall in Pittsburg will have in person advance voting available on Friday, October 30, 2020, from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM and on Saturday, October 31, 2020, from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Any voter registered in Crawford County can vote at these locations.

The Crawford County Clerk's office on the second floor of the Crawford County Courthouse at 111 E. Forest in Girard has in person advance voting available from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on weekdays and ending on Monday, November 2, 2020, at noon.

Polling places will be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the final voting in the 2020 General Election. A few of our polling places have changed and all voters that were affected were notified with a letter. If you are not sure of the location of your polling place you can look it up online at Voter View of Kansas at www.myvoteinfo.voteks.org or you can call the office of the Crawford County Clerk at 620-724-6115.

Whether you are voting in person at one of our advance voting locations or on Election Day, November 3, 2020, at one of our polling places, we encourage all of you to wear a face mask, to observe social distancing guidelines and to wash

your hands appropriately. We will be doing our best to make sure that you are safe in all of our polling places and we want our election workers to be safe also.
