Last Chance to Register for General Election

The deadline in Kansas to register to vote for the General Election is Tuesday, October 13, 2020. This is also the last date to update your voter information, such as an address change, before the General Election on November 3, 2020. You can check your current registration information and make changes or you can register to vote online at www.myvoteinfo.voteks.org or at www.ksvotes.org.

There are still several opportunities for voters to cast their ballot before election day, both in person and by mail. Advance ballots by mail can be applied for until October 27, 2020, but you are encouraged to apply for them as soon as possible if you choose to vote by mail. Advance ballots will start being mailed out on October 14, 2020. Crawford County will have 2 drop boxes available for voters to return their ballots which will be emptied on a daily basis by election workers. They will be located in the parking areas of the Crawford County Judicial Center located at 602 N. Locust Street in Pittsburg and at the Crawford County Courthouse located at 111 E. Forest Street in Girard.

The Homer Cole Center at 3003 North Joplin St. in Pittsburg and the Meadowbrook Mall in Pittsburg will have in person advance voting available on Friday, October 30, 2020, from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM and on Saturday, October 31, 2020, from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

The Crawford County Clerk's office on the second floor of the Crawford County Courthouse at 111 E. Forest in Girard will have in person advance voting available beginning on Wednesday, October 14, 2020, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on weekdays and ending on Monday, November 2, 2020, at noon.

Polling places will be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the final voting in the 2020 General Election. A few of our polling places have changed and all voters that were affected were notified with a letter. If you are not sure of the location of your polling place you can look it up online at Voter View of Kansas at www.myvoteinfo.voteks.org or you can call the office of the Crawford County Clerk at 620-724-6115.

Whether you are voting in person at one of our advance voting locations or on Election Day, November 3, 2020, at one of our polling places, we encourage all of you to wear a face mask, to observe social distancing guidelines and to wash your hands appropriately. We will be doing our best to make sure that you are safe in all of our polling places and we want our election workers to be safe also.
