GLENWOOD CEMETERY
Walnut

Located nr. SE cor. of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 14, Twp. 28S, Rge 21 E.

This is $\frac{1}{2}$ mi. N of the highway that passes E-W through Walnut, on the W side of the road. St. Patrick's Catholic cen. adjoins Glenwood on the S. The 1906 Plat Book of Crawford Co., Kans., shows this cemetery area occupying 10 acres, but shows no distinction between the two. It would then appear that Glenwood occupies the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sect. 14, and St. Patrick's occupies the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of same. A fence separates the two.

11-17-1971 Miss Ethel Pate of Walnut has the Glenwood cem. records. They do not record the first burial, but the Charter shows issue date of July 30, 1897, and the corporation had 6 trustees: J. M. Goff, W. F. Pharis, J. P. Morgan, P.W. Curtis, Geo. W. Singleton, T. F. Jones.

The Glenwood cem., operating as a corporation, has to file an income tax report each year, however they received a letter of exemption Sept 13 1934. It is supported partly by the Township fund, and partly by donations. It appears to be well kept.

Glenwood was the first name for Walnut; the Walnut P. O. was then on the Frear farm 2 mi E & 1 mi S. When Mr. Frear moved his P. O. to Glenwood, the name was then changed to Walnut. However, this Glenwood cem. is of much more recent date than the older Walnut cem., $1\frac{1}{2}$ mi further N.

Mr. J. M. Goff was a major in the Civil War. His dau. Miss Florence still resides in Walnut, and his son was a banker there; another dau. was Mrs. Phil Cambell, whose husband was a prominent political figure of some years ago. Miss Florence Goff explained that in the "horse & buggy days" many people thought the old cem. 2 mi. N was too far away, so the new one was started closer to town, rather than adjoining the older one.

Mr. George Singleton^{Sr.}, one of the first trustees, buried his first wife in the old Walnut cem. Their sons later moved their mother's body to Glenwood.

There are 3 driveways into the cem., dividing it into 4 sections N-S. The N & S sections are very narrow, so were just copied from E to W, ignoring row numbers. The 2 larger central sections, between the 3 driveways, were copied separately by rows, beginning with E and working to W; the N section was copied 1st, thence to the S. The center drive has a "gazebo" about 2/3 of the way to the back, the driveway dividing around it.

Following the date of the Charter, July 30, 1897, we find 3 burials in 1897 and 5 each in 1898, 1899 & 1900. One other burial dated only 1897 may be before or after July 30th. We found 6 burials preceding 1897:
