GREENBUSH CATHOLIC CEMETERY (St. Francis or St. Aloysius)

or Hickory

Located NW of Sect. 22 Twp. 29S Rg. 22E

This is 8 mi. W of the highway intersection in Girard Kans., on the S side of highway #57. The 1906 Crawford Co. atlas shows the church and cemetery occupying 10 acres in the NE cor of the above quarter section, having a frontage along the highway of 1/16 mi., and depth N-S of $\frac{1}{4}$ mi, the cemetery occupying a part of the S portion of this area, and not easily visible from the road.

Father Torline, whose residence is at the rear of the church, said the church was established in 1871, and thought it likely the earliest graves would date about 1872. (2 earliest found: 1872) The original church was frame and was used perhaps 6 or 8 years, and was said to have been located $\frac{1}{2}$ mi S of the present site. The large stone church with tall spire, a landmark which can be seen for several miles, is the 3rd church building, the 2nd church having been also of stone stands to the E of the present church, and is now the parish hall.

It was said that the original cemetery name was St. Francis cem.. From 1871 to 1883 the church was a mission from St. Francis ch. at St. Paul. The cemetery records begin about 1883, but it might be possible that earlier records are at St. Paul. The present name of the parish, St. Aloysius, might also apply to this cem.

The road leading back to the cemetery encircles it, there being about 10 rows of stones within this original part, with 2 rows of recent graves to the E of the E drive. There is much room for future expansion to the S and W, now planted to soybeans. The cem. is very neatly kept. The stones are not is straight rows making it extremely difficult to copy in a logical order. We attempted to copy the W row first, then working to the E, but the stones are so out of line that someone using our copy might easily disagree on which row some of the stones are in. The plat was known to exist about 30 years ago, but has now been lost. All burials were of the Catholic faith, although it is likely some travelers were buried here in early days whose membership may have been in other parishes.

10-27-1971 Milton McClintick of 3 mi E & 2 mi S of Walnut told of obituaries in the Walnut paper, probably in the 1880's, stating that burials were made in "Hickory" cem. He inquired and learned that this was another name for Greenbush in early days.

In the March 1973 issue of "The Seeker", p. 5, marriages from the Osage Journal, James Hayden & Cora Mudd were married at the Hickory Catholic Church, Thursday, Nov. 9, 1893, by Fr. Verdan.

GREENBUSH CEMETERY MOTES

12-5-1971: Mr. & Mrs. Raymond LaForge live a short distance E of Greenbush Catholic Church on N side of road ($E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $SE_4^{\frac{1}{2}}$ Sect. 15). Mr. LaForge's grandfather Xavier LaFouge (original spelling LaFouge—but many years before in France LaFouvge) came from France and settled here just after the Civil War and built the stone house where they now live. He was a stone mason and found it necessary to travel some to practice his trade, and left his 15 year old son in charge of the family.

Father F. M. Verdan was the first resident pastor of the parish and lived with the Xavier LaFouge family about 2 years. The first stone church was built during that time. It is now the parish hall to the E of the present stone church. Previous to the first stone church there was a frame church ½ mi. S but it was destroyed by a tornado after being used perhaps 3 or 4 years. By that time the road was established where highway #57 is now, so the new church was built facing the road. Mr. LaForge was certain there had never been any graves across the road N of the church. He believed the reference could have been to those at Mills School about 2 mi N.

4-27-1973: Found at St. Paul Public Library: "The Legend of Greenbush" by W. W. Graves, St. Paul editor, copyright 1907.

In late spring of 1869, probably 4-23-1869, Father Philip Colleton, S. J. (Society of Jesus or Jesuits) who was born 11-1-1831 Ire., was on way from Crawfordsville to Osage Mission when caught in a terrible storm. He promised to build a church on the site if spared. The 1st church, frame bldg., was built before March 1871. The 2nd of stone; the 3rd also stone dedicated 7-9-1907, 12 x 130, while Pittsburg church is only 62*140. A grove of hickory trees on the bank of a nearby creek gave the creek the name of Hickory Creek, and this church was known as Hickory Creek Church until 1890, when it became known as Greenbush. Early settlers mentioned included names of James Donahue, Delphine community.

2-7-1974: Pat O'Reilly, who grew up in this community but 1 ved in Girard from 1898, told that he had always heard that his mother's brother, Pat Smith, was the first person buried in the Greenbush Cemetery. He believed his parents came in 1870, and Pat Smith a short time before, they had lived in Canada before coming to Kansas. Pat Smith's stone was a rock with the initials "P.S." carved on it. Once when the cemetery was being cleaned, a priest decided to do away with all the old rocks, and it was discarded. It was in the northwest part of the cemetery.
