RESOLUTION 2019-021

A RESOLUTION CREATING A SPECIAL AMBULANCE RESERVE FUND PURSUANT TO K.S.A. §12-110d.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. \$12-110d authorizes the governing body of any municipality to transfer annually, by resolution, any funds received from a tax levy specifically authorized to be made for an ambulance or emergency medical service to a special fund for the replacement of ambulance or emergency medical service equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interests of the County to establish a special ambulance reserve fund for the replacement of equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Crawford County, Kansas:

 $\frac{\text{Section 1}}{\text{Reserve Fund.}} \text{ There is hereby created a Special}$ $\frac{\text{Reserve Fund.}}{\text{Reserve Fund.}} \text{ This fund can be used to replace}$ equipment for the Ambulance Department.}

Section 2. If the Board of County Commissioners determines that money which has been transferred into the Special Ambulance Reserve Fund is not needed for the purposes for which it was transferred the Board of County Commissioners may by resolution retransfer such amount not needed to the County Ambulance Fund.

 $\underline{\text{Section 3}}$. The County Clerk is hereby directed to deliver a copy of this resolution to the County Treasurer.
