Item One: Mr. Ray Ryan, Ryan Insurance, reviewing county property, casualty and workers compensation insurance claims. Mr. Ryan discussed the work comp premiums with the Commissioners. He explained how the premiums amounts through EMC are calculated. He handed the Commissioners a report on the claims and the insurance premiums. There was a discussion on the issue of the first 7 days that an employee is off on a work comp claim, the county paying those wages and how the county can be reimbursed for those 7 days. There was discussion on the issue of an employee being gone only 2 or 3 days with an injury. Mr. Emerson stated that the county pays those wages and not the insurance company. Mr. Pyle stated that he will contact the Kansas Department of Labor to discuss these issues and the questions the Commissioners have.
