MESSAGES FROM APPOINTED OFFICIALS

Item One: Ms. Janis Goedeke, Mr. Rick Pfeiffer and Mr. Brad Stroud presenting a Grant Report. Ms. Goedeke introduced Live Well Crawford County Director Mr. Brad Stroud. Mr. Stroud presented the Commissioners with an outline of the different grants and activities through Live Well Crawford County. He explained the Pathways to a Healthy Kansas Grant that Live Well was awarded. He stated that the grant funding has grown to \$400,000 over a 3 year period. Mr. Stroud also spoke about the Growing Growers program which teaches young people how to grow produce. He explained the High Tunnel Green house which will be located at the C Tec Building in the Pittsburg Industrial Park and that grant money will fund the high tunnel project. He also stated that he is working on establishing a dual credit program for the area high schools that do not have agricultural programs. Mr. Stroud also explained the Hero Grant (Healthily Eating Rural Opportunities) through the Sunflower Foundation and the plans the committee has for this grant. Mr. Stroud addressed the ATAB (Active Transportation Advisory Board) and stated that the board meets every 3 months. He discussed some areas that the board may be working on for bicycle and walking trails. Mr. Stroud wanted to invite everyone to the Live Well Crawford County Annual Meeting and Social at Memorial Auditorium from 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM on January 11. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Stroud for the work he is doing and they look forward to watching the program grow. Ms. Goedeke spoke about plans for a certified kitchen in the health department and their search for funding. She also stated that she is excited at the progress of Live Well Crawford County.


