Item One: Mr. John Mareth addressing the Commissioners in reference to a business in Arma and obtaining a tax abatement. Mr. Mareth stated that he is with Prime Investments

and this company currently has an offer to purchase Stress Panel Manufacturing in Arma. He gave some background information on himself and the company he is with. Mr. Mareth also informed the Commissioners of the background of the current Stress Panel Manufacturing business and the current owners. He stated that he and his investors feel that there is a future in this business. He explained that Stress Panel is still in business at this time but in the last five years had only 1 year in the black. Mr. Mareth answered the Commissioners that the current business only has 3-part time employees and his projection is to have 12 to 14 full time employees in the future. The City of Arma has approved helping the company apply for a 5-year tax abatement but this has to be applied for at the state level. Mr. Mareth stated that he just wants to inform the Commissioners of his intent and explain his plans. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Mareth for his presentation and stated they will help with a tax abatement if needed.
