On motion (16-200) of Commissioner Wood and the second of Commissioner Moody to approve the 2016 Application for Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Funds from the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and authorize the Chairman to sign.

Item Two: Mr. Rick Pfeiffer with follow up on the White Paper Report on the Town Hall Meetings and architect reports. Mr. Pfeiffer introduced architect Dwight Brennfoerder and stated that Mr. Brennfoerder will give a presentation on the architectural report. Mr. Pfeiffer handed out the Architect's analysis. Mr. Brennfoerder stated that he works out of Joplin and has been in architecture since 1972. He gave a presentation on the architectural analysis and explained the details of the presentation. Mr. Brennfoerder explained how to bring the current building up to required guidelines for fire protection and how to add on to the current building. Mr. Murphy asked about keeping the facility open during construction. There was a discussion of the facility going to Pittsburg and the facility in Girard being used for adolescent addiction treatment. The Commissioners asked Mr. Pfeiffer about 1 mill raising 1 million dollars over 4 years and Mr. Pfeiffer stated he could raise the other million dollars needed for construction. Mr. Chris Weiner, Girard City Administrator, stated that the City does not want to lose the facility in Girard. Mr. Weiner stated that this is not a bad investment. Mr. Wood would like a ½ mill for a 2 year period. Mr. Pfeiffer will come back Friday when Mr. Emerson is present.

MESSAGES FROM ELECTION OFFICIALS PROCLAMATIONS AND ORDERS OF THE BOARD NEW BUSINESS

Item One: Commissioner Murphy regarding the mowing tractors. The Commissioners discussed the shortage of mowers with one of the mowers down. Mr. Murphy spoke about renting a mower to share between the 3 districts and the Commissioners talked about the repairs needed for the mower that is out of operation.

Item Two: Commissioner Wood addressed the condition of the Fairgrounds. Mr. Weiner, Girard City Administrator stated that it was his understanding that the Fair Board would maintain the grounds. Mr. Wood stated that he is concerned about poles and powers lines still down from the recent storm. Mr. Wood asked Mr. Weiner if the City of Girard could set the poles and string the lines as a courtesy and to help out the Fair Board. The Commissioners discussed this being the 100 year anniversary of the Crawford County Fair and they would like all entities to work together in assisting the Fair Board to make the grounds look as nice as possible. Mr. Weiner explained that the City is short on employees at this time and is struggling to keep up with the City's work. Mr. Murphy asked about liability on the property with the electrical lines being down. Mr. Wood stated that the fairgrounds represent the entire county and all entities should help out and work together. Mr. Murphy feels maybe the Convention and Visitors Bureau could help with more funding or donations. Mr. Moody suggested having a meeting with Mr. Weiner, Girard City Administrator, a representative from the Fair Board, the Commissioners and B.J. Harris, Director of the Convention and Visitor's Bureau. Ms. Julie Smith, Director of the Girard Chamber of Commerce stated that she will work on setting up a meeting with the individuals requested.

Item Three: Mr. Moody asked about striping the roads. Mr. Wood would like to have a work session with Mr. Mike Peak, Sign Foreman, on Tuesday, June 21 at 9:30 AM to discuss this.
