CRAWFORD COUNTY COURTHOUSE, COMMISSIONERS' BOARD ROOM Girard, KS Friday, March 17, 2017, 10:00 AM

The Crawford County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated Chapter 19, Article 2, Section 18 in due and regular session with open doors. Commissioner Carl Wood served as the presiding officer.

Commissioners Tom Moody and Jeff Murphy were in attendance.

County Clerk Don Pyle and County Counselor Jim Emerson were seated with the Board. Chairman Wood led the pledge of allegiance.

UNDER THE HEADING NEW BUSINESS PUBLIC HEARINGS AND OPENING OF ANNOUNCED BIDS MESSAGES FROM THE COUNTY LOCAL BOARD OF HEALTH

Item One: Mr. Rick Pfeiffer and Ms. Janis Goedeke discussing Health Department issues. Mr. Pfeiffer read a letter from Ms. Janis Goedeke, Health Officer, stating that she is resigning her position as Health Officer effective April 1, 2017. Mr. Pfeiffer handed out a folder with information on the 1995 Crawford County Resolution that formed the Organizational Chart for the Health Department, the Executive Administrators job

description and the Health Officers job description, and a Selection Plan which is an organization work chart to find and replace this position. Mr. Pfeiffer explained the information in the folder and gave the Commissioners their options. He explained what took place with the 1995 Resolution and explained how he was paid at that time and during the years and how he now receives his salary for his position with the Health Department and his position with the Mental Health Department. He also explained tort coverage and how it has changed over the years. He stated that since Ms. Goedeke is resigning effective April 1, 2017, a decision needs to be made on how to replace that position. Mr. Pfeiffer explained appointing an Interim Health officer or hiring an active officer under probation through himself. He explained that an interim does not want the job but just fills in until someone is hired. He also stated that he has an individual interested in being the Interim Health Officer until a Health Officer is hired. He said that there are capable people to serve as an interim employed at the Health Department.

Mr. Emerson explained the state statute 65-201 and stated that the Board of Commissioners serves as the Board of Health. He said that with a population of less than 100,000 the Board of Commissioners can appoint a Health Officer. Mr. Pfeiffer stated that Dr. Koehn is the consultant for the Health Department and that the staff nurses do all the work and the physician just consults. Ms. Goedeke stated that Dr. Koehn is located in Pittsburg and he comes every two weeks and is paid \$60.00 per hour for his time. She stated that this is a very minimal charge and he is very dedicated. Mr. Pfeiffer explained the difference between the Health Director and the Health Officer and stated that Ms. Goedeke currently holds both positions. Ms. Goedeke gave job descriptions on both positions. She answered Mr. Murphy that she supervises a staff of 25 and has programs in multiple counties. Mr. Murphy stated that the county policy is to advertise all vacant positions and to interview at least 2 applicants for every position. RESOLUTION 95-203

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING RICK PFEIFFER AS EXECUTIVE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CRAWFORD COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 21, 1995, AND ESTABLISHING ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1996.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. § <u>65-201</u> the Board of County Commissioners shall act as the County Board of Health for their respective county, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners in counties with less than one hundred thousand (100,000) population may appoint a qualified local health program administrator as the local health officer, and

WHEREAS, the selection of a Local Health Officer is an appointment to meet duties defined in K.S.A. 65-202, and

WHEREAS, a designated person licensed to practice medicine and surgery or person licensed to practice dentistry is a consultant to direct the Local Health Officer on program and related medical, and

WHEREAS, in May of 1995 the Board of County Commissioners appointed an Advisory Committee to make recommendations regarding the structure and administration of the Crawford County Health Department, and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee and Board of County Commissioners sought and received input from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the recommendations of the Advisory Committee the Board of County Commissioners feel it is in the best interests of service access and fiscal management to appoint Rick Pfeiffer as the Executive Administrator of the Crawford County Health Department, and

WHEREAS, an Organizational Chart in compliance with K.S.A. Chapter 65 is here attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Crawford County, Kansas:

Section 1. Appointment of Executive Administrator. The Board of County Commissioners hereby appoints Rick Pfeiffer as



Administrator of the Crawford County Health Department effective December 21, 1995.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Compensation</u>. The Health Department Executive Administrator shall receive compensation at the rate of One Dollar (\$1.00) per month, which amount can be revised by the Board of County Commissioners from time to time as they determine necessary.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Duties</u>. The Health Department Executive Administrator shall direct to be performed the duties specified in Kansas Statutes and Administrative Regulations, specifically including K.S.A. 65-202 <u>et.seq.</u>, and shall report along with the Local Health Officer to the County Board of Health as necessary to inform the County Board of Health on public health issues.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Employment at Will</u>. The Administrator shall hold office at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners and may be terminated at anytime with or without cause.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

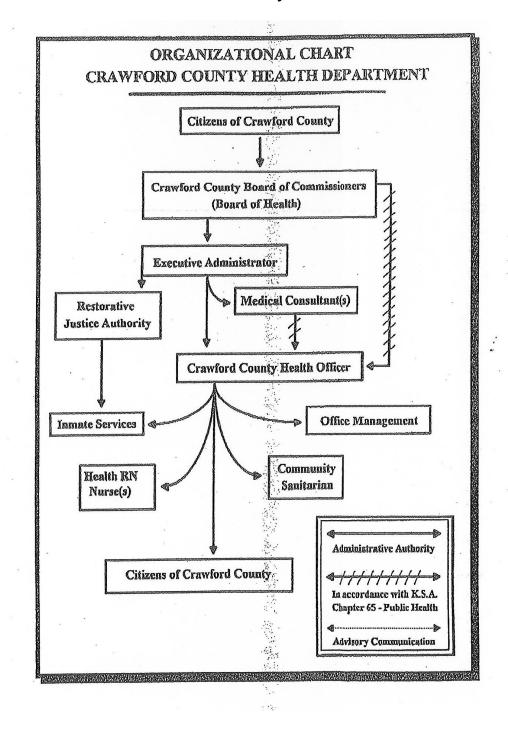
