Mt. CARMEL CEMETERY---located on NW cor. of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 22, Twp. 30 South, Range 22 East. Mt. Carmel School, now removed, once occupied the corner across the road north from the cem. Mrs. Margaret Davis Gibson told us of this cem., and said some bodies were moved to other cemeteries. Notes taken April 14, 1961, by William & Jessie Cuthbertson. This cem. is in a sad state, brush and weeds so covered some stones it was very difficult to get to them, and possibly we did not find all of the stones.

Edie T. Son of J. & R. Fawcett born Dec. 2, 1876 died Sep. 3, 1882.

James D. son of J. & R. Fawcett born Feb. 17, 1864 died Sep. 30, 1882
Dearest child thou hast left us
And thy loss we deeply feel (hand with finger pointing up)
Tis the Lord that has bereft us
Of one we loved so well.

Emma J. dau. of J. & R. Fawcett born Mar. 29, 1866 died Mar. 4, 1889
Then parents dear dry up that tear
No longer linger o'er my grave (design of book and words: Holy Bible)
In Heaven so dear there's naught to fear
I know that Jesus Christ can save.

Fawcett John Aug. 26, 1837 May 29, 1913 Father Rachel his wife Aug. 21, 1840
Dec. 14, 1917 Mother. (large granite stone, overturned)

Mary A. Quesenbery born Aug. 5, 1834 died Jan. 7, 1885
