At the W edge of Arcadia, turn N just W of the railroad tracks & follow the road R a little more than & ri. to where it crosses Cox Creek; at this point the road turns W, and the entrance to the cem, is to the E.

This com, appears to consist of 3 sections: a very old section to the E, a later section in the center, and a newer one to the A. In the older E part we found this stone: (p. 7) "Hathaway Philip E. 1816-1673 Elizabeth 1619-1858 Lucy C. 1846-1860". Also on the same stone: "This cemetery dedicated to wife blizabeth who was first to sleep herein." Land records show that Phillip W. Bathaway rec'd a land patent from the U.S.Govt. on May 6 1670 to the E2 of May of this section; but previously brown that this way had made a deed, 11-11-1869, to Wa. ". Buckman. The 1906 Atlas of Crawford Co. shows a cem. at this place, slightly angled, and longer E-W than N-S; we believe it may have extended farther E than the present t boundary. This was likely known as the Arcadia cem. in early days.

(Christoph r Schmidt)

Forest Hill Cem. was plotted 6-22-1699, Christoph Schmitt, owner, the description being as follows: Commencing 11 rods S of NE cor of SW, of WS, of above Sect. 36, W 15 rods, S 32 rods, E 15 rods, W 32 rods to beginning, EXCEPTING therefrom a part of the Arcadis Kansas Sem. The plat shows that this covers the old E and later willle sections, and was 520° along the E and W sides, and 2172° along the N & S cods. The older part is shown to be the NE part, nugling in such a way as to leave some wedge-shaped pieces, but approx. 362° long N-C and 1513° wide N-W, Therefore the S 166° of the old a part appears to have been platted with the middle section in 1899.

The new west section is properly called "heat Ridge Add, to Forest Hill Cem." & was platted in 1931 by James L. bearing, surveyor. It was dedicated by Amelia Brumbarger, aidow, 11-13-1931, and described as follows: Commencing 9' % of 5% cor. of lot 1956 of the Forest Hill cem. (said lot 1956 being duly recorded), N 1551, % 3001, S 2001, thence in Kürtheasterly direction 3051 to place of beginning.

"Gld breadis" scens to be the name everyone uses for this com., Mr. Trumen Ballard who is in charge of the cem. had not heard of the name Forest Hill. He owns land to the N & E. He said the town of Arcadia began here and was later moved to its present location.

The cem. is well-kept for an old one, 2 men were spreading dirt in sunken places and cutting brush in fence rows. The location is on a hill with much brush around it, Cox creek flows to the S & E a short distance. It was extremely difficult to copy the eldest E part by rows, due to the fact these rows angled variously; likely this is due to the fact that the old part was laid off at a slight angle originally.

Hr. Ed Dobbins (12-13-1971) a barber at Arcadia, extremely well-versed in Arcadia history, was keeper of the cem. records for about 26 rears, before Ur. Ballard had them. He recalled the name of Forest Hill, but said no one used it. He said the HE part was an older constery, Mr. Schmidt, once a barber in M.C., omed land to the W, and his day, was Hrs. brumbarger, who lived in the house to the W, was the mother of tra. Doaring who cannot the new W add.

br. Cody Bailey (12-13-1971) residing 1 mi 2 of Arcadia, 3 mi N & 3 At N recelled helping dig graves here as a young man. We had heard the story that a number of people died of smallpox in an epidemic in early days, and some were even buried here in the middle of the night. Ars. Dearing, other of lots in the new 4 part, now living in Ft. Scott, was related to those buried at the Dearing or Names Com. SE of Cato.

Mrs. Madde Jewell Evans, new Taylor (12-18-1971), stated that her mother-index was a nathoway. Thillip hathaway lived just W of the com. on the next little hill. His wife Wirelateth was ill, probably of consumption. The called cut the window to him that when she died she wanted to be buried over on the little kidll—and he carried out her wishes, so that she was the first one buried have. In mathaway was a blacksmith. Col. Jewell was first buried at the battle of Cane Hill in Ark., then moved to the Natilian. at Pt. Scott, and later moved to this cem. Joe Welson was first postmaster at the called which was leasted to the Natilians.
