## PITTSBURG ZION LUTHERAN CEMETERY

Located NW cor of S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sect. 33, Twp. 30S, Rge 25E.

This is 1 mi E and 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  mi S of Fourth & Broadway in Pittsburg, Kans., on E side of Rouse St., about 3/4 mi N. of the new Mt. Carmel Hospital corner.

The cem. is long E-W, and all the graves are in the E end, which is divided from the W end by a ravine. The 1906 Crawford Co. Atlas map shows a church in the W part. The sign at the road : "Zion Lutheran Cemetery, Church Address Broadway & Jackson". It is well kept and well fenced; the gate was chained but not locked. Many stones are in German, and we feel we did not do a very good job of transcribing these. The road divides the cem. into a N part and a S part. We copied the N Part first, working from W to E, then the S part, also working from W to E.
