VANDERMULIEN FAMILY

Located N_2^1 of Sect. 33, Tup. 20S, R. 25E

2-25-1972: Mrs. Harry Hay of Arma stated that her grandparents, John & Sarah Vandermullen came from Holland and homesteaded a farm at this location. The family Bible showed they had 18 children, all of whom died but four. Several are buried in the Fulberry Cem., but several are unaccounted for. It is believed the other Vandermullen children are buried near the site of the farm home, which was about mid-way along W side of this section, and less than $\frac{1}{2}$ ni to the E, back from the road. A large evergreen tree and a very big elm mark the homestead. Since the family knew of no markers, we did not walk over this site. This is 1 mi E of highway 69 at Arma, and $\frac{1}{2}$ mi N on E side. Mrs. Hay knew all the children were born on this farm
